	<p>The Faculty of Economics University of Belgrade has undergraduate programme Economics, Business Management and Statistics, with 12 modules. The Faculty also offers 8 academic master programmes and PhD programmes in Economics, Business Management, Statistics and Demography.</p> <p>The Faculty of Economics strives to provide the top class education in accounting and finance, which would be fully aligned with the best international practice. Since 1966 the Faculty has been providing the specialized undergraduate module for accounting and finance. In the recent period students' interest for this module is stable and high. Around 20% of all students choose to study <i>Accounting, Auditing and Financial Management</i> and more than half of them find their first job in 6 months after graduation. On master level, students could continue their studies in this field by enrolling the programme <i>Accounting, Auditing and Business Finance</i>.</p> <p>Currently the curriculum of the accounting programmes does not content specific courses in public sector accounting and governmental auditing.</p> <p>The curriculum is revised periodically (in 5 years accreditation cycles). Next accreditation is planned in 2019, and the Faculty is just starting preparing for this process. It is the chance to discuss the possibility of integrating new courses or new contents in existing courses in each programme, including accounting one. Providing accounting students with competencies in public sector accounting and governmental auditing is widely recognized as important and this issue will be actively considered at the Department of Accounting and Business Finance.</p>
